WHEREAS, the Green Carbon Inc. is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Japan, with business address at 6F Spline Aoyama Tokyu Building, 3-1-3 Minami-Aoyama, Minato-ku Tokyo, Japan;

WHEREAS, the planting of Mangroves in the municipality of San Benito, Siargao Island is one of the projects initiated by Green Carbon Inc. which aim to generate carbon credits by utilizing the vast mangroves found in the San Benito, Siargao island;

WHEREAS, the plantation of mangroves using its propagules requires at about 20,000 hectares of planting area in San Benito, where the local farmers / mangrove growers are being utilize to plant mangrove trees with corresponding payment as a way of livelihood intervention,
